Executive Summary

Together, we turned challenges into opportunities for impact as Blue Haven Foundation (BHF) continued to champion its mission of empowering women and girls from underserved communities through scholarships and wellness-focused learning programs that create pathways to brighter, more equitable futures. In three short years, we had tremendous growth.

This year represented a powerful season of growth, resilience, and generosity. Despite an economic climate marked by widespread corporate layoffs, BHF saw increased support from individual donors through both one-time and recurring gifts. We also broadened our grant-seeking efforts, strengthening our funding pipeline and reinforcing the foundation for long-term sustainability.

To further elevate visibility and deepen community connection, BHF launched branded apparel and collectible pins—creative awareness tools that supported our hands-on, frontline engagement in the communities we serve.

It was an active and high-impact year, defined by meaningful programs and milestones. Highlights included the *Light the Night* Halloween Book Drive, *Boobs & Bling: Strike A Pose* Breast Cancer Education & Wellness event, and the awarding of monies to eight young women—contributing to a 20% increase in overall scholarship giving. We also proudly welcomed two new grant funders, introduced our first silent auction with live giving, advanced planning for the launch of our Polished Pearls program in 2026, and invested in the systems and tools needed to enhance donor engagement and giving.

Each milestone reflects our unwavering commitment to education, wellness, and opportunity—and to creating lasting, generational change for the women and girls we serve.

More Connections for Girls

Looking ahead, Blue Haven Foundation will soft launch ***Polished Pearls: Future Leaders Program***, a **flagship initiative** designed to prepare high-potential young women from underserved communities to become confident, college-ready, and career-driven leaders. Like a pearl—refined, resilient, and rare—each participant is supported in developing the skills, confidence, and purpose needed to thrive academically, professionally, and personally.

Polished Pearls is built on **three core pillars: Girls With Grit, Pearl Partners, and BHF Connect**. Together, these components provide mentorship, college readiness, life skills training, leadership development, and career exposure. Programs include peer-to-peer conversations with college students, a Big Sister-style mentorship model for incoming freshmen, and career networking with professionals and alumni.

In its **inaugural year**, the program will serve **10–20 participants**, providing access to mentorship, leadership experiences, and essential tools such as laptops or tablets, along with branded program materials. Expected outcomes include increased confidence and resilience, stronger college preparation, improved scholarship readiness, a greater sense of belonging, community engagement, and sustained access to personal and professional guidance.

Polished Pearls represents an **investment in the next generation** of empowered leaders and changemakers.
